



Medicare Advantage Plans Compliance & FWA Training Statement of Attestation

Attestation Summary

The Medicare Modernization Act (MMA) passed in 2003 includes a requirement for all Medicare Part D plans to have in place a program to control Fraud, Waste, and Abuse (FWA) activity. The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) announced that beginning with the 2009 plan year, all health plans must incorporate FWA guidelines into their compliance plan to ensure that all contracted entities, including network providers and pharmacies, have received training to detect, correct, and prevent Medicare FWA.

In general, anyone who participates in the provision of the Part D benefit, either through interaction with a Medicare patient or through medications dispensed to Medicare beneficiaries, all downstream individuals involved in the administration or delivery of the Medicare benefit is required to complete annual compliance and FWA training as defined under 42 CFR 423.504(b)(vi)(H). This regulatory requirement must be completed annually.
